Before & After School Services

Cedar Tree Academy provides a fee-based, before- and after-school program for students and parents who require additional care outside of the normal schedule of the school day. Both services are staffed with highly trained individuals who will assist students in academic and recreational activities.

Cedar Tree's Before Care Program begins at 6:30 AM each day. Parents are required to sign students in and leave them in the main office each morning. At the conclusion of the program, students will be escorted to their classroom for daily instruction.

Cedar Tree's After Care Program begins at dismissal and concludes at 6:00 PM. Parents must pick students up promptly at 6:00 PM. Parents of students who remain on the school's premises after the 6:00 PM dismissal will be charged a fee of \$5 per minute, which must be paid the same day as the infraction.

Students enrolled in Before/After Care services will participate in several activities, such as: homework, games, arts and crafts, and other educational and recreational activities.

Below are the fees associated with attending Before/After Care:

Before Care ONLY--\$60 (1st child: \$60; 2nd/3rd sibling: \$37.50 per child) paid twice a month;

After Care ONLY--\$75 (1st child: \$75; 2nd/3rd sibling: \$47.50 per child) paid twice a month; and

Before/After Care--\$110 (1st child: \$110; 2nd/3rd sibling: \$62.50 per child) paid twice a month.

Once enrolled in Before/After Care, you will receive a payment schedule. Payments will be collected semi-monthly. All payments must be in the form of credit card/debit payment ONLY (No cash or Cash App payments will be accepted). Late payments will incur a charge of \$10.00 per day.

In addition, students enrolled in Before/After Care will follow the same behavior policy implemented at Cedar Tree during the regular school day.

Cedar Tree Academy's Uniform Policy

Student behavior and the school environment are strongly influenced by the dress and appearance of students. To help create an environment conducive to learning, students at Cedar Tree Academy are required to wear uniforms. This policy is designed to allow students to focus on academic and character development. The school uniform consists of the following:

Bottoms

Boys may wear khaki pants or shorts, and girls may wear khaki pants, knee-length skirts, skorts, shorts or jumpers. Skirts, shorts, and jumpers must be able to pass the finger length test. Standing with your hands at your side, the item must be longer than your fingertips. These items may be purchased at most department stores or clothing outlets. Floor-length skirts, baggy or wide-legged pants, or allowing pants to sag are not permitted. Denim is not allowed, unless authorized by the school principal.

Tops

Both girls and boys must wear green polo-style shirts or t-shirts with the Cedar Tree Academy school logo.

Shoes

Students are permitted to wear closed—toe shoes. Sandals and other opened—toe shoes are not allowed as these shoes may cause harm while students are engaged in activities.
