### **DRAFT CONTENT:**

Cedar Tree Academy encourages students, families, and staff to consider the many convenient and affordable ways to travel to and from school. Depending on your trip, you may be able to take Metrorail or Metrobus, bike, use Capital Bikeshare, or share a ride through a carpool or vanpool.

Explore the resources below to find a transportation option that best fits your schedule.

### **Carpool & Vanpool**

Carpooling is a convenient and affordable way for families and staff to share rides with others who have similar routes and schedules. Ridesharing can help reduce transportation costs, ease traffic around the school, lower vehicle emissions, and make daily trips more convenient.

Families can use SchoolPool to connect with other parents and caregivers for school-related carpools. Staff can use Commuter Connections to find carpool and vanpool partners for their daily commute.

#### **For Parents:** SchoolPool

*Description:* The SchoolPool app connects parents and students within the same school community to arrange carpools. The platform is free to use and can help reduce traffic during arrival and dismissal while saving families time and transportation costs.

#### **For Staff:** Commuter Connections

*Description:* Commuter Connections is a regional network of transportation organizations working to improve commutes in the Washington metropolitan area. Staff can use the program to find carpool and vanpool partners, locate Park & Ride lots, access transit information, and explore additional commuter benefits and resources.

## **Bicycle & Micromobility**

Cedar Tree Academy provides facilities for students and staff who bike or scooter to school. Fourteen bicycle parking spaces are available near the school entrance for daily use by students and visitors.

Staff also have access, at no cost, to a secure bicycle storage room inside the school. The room includes four long-term bicycle parking spaces, three showers, and three lockers.

The closest Capital Bikeshare station is on Shannon Place east of Howard Road, which is a six-minute walk from the school. To find more bikeshare stations near you and information on memberships, you can access the Capital Bike Share [website](#) and download the Capital Bikeshare [mobile app](#).

For students, families, or staff who are new to bicycling, the Washington Area Bicycle Association (WABA) offers bike skills classes throughout the year. Class schedules and registration are available [here](#).

## **Transit Connections**

Cedar Tree Academy is conveniently served by both Metrorail and Metrobus.

Eligible District residents between the ages of 5 and 21 may ride Metrobus and Metrorail at no cost through the Kids Ride Free program.

Use WMATA's [Trip Planner](#) to plan your commute from any location. Those who drive can also use park-and-ride facilities at select Metrorail stations to combine driving with transit. Park-and-ride locations are available [here](#). The [Transit app](#) is another convenient option for planning your trip to the school.

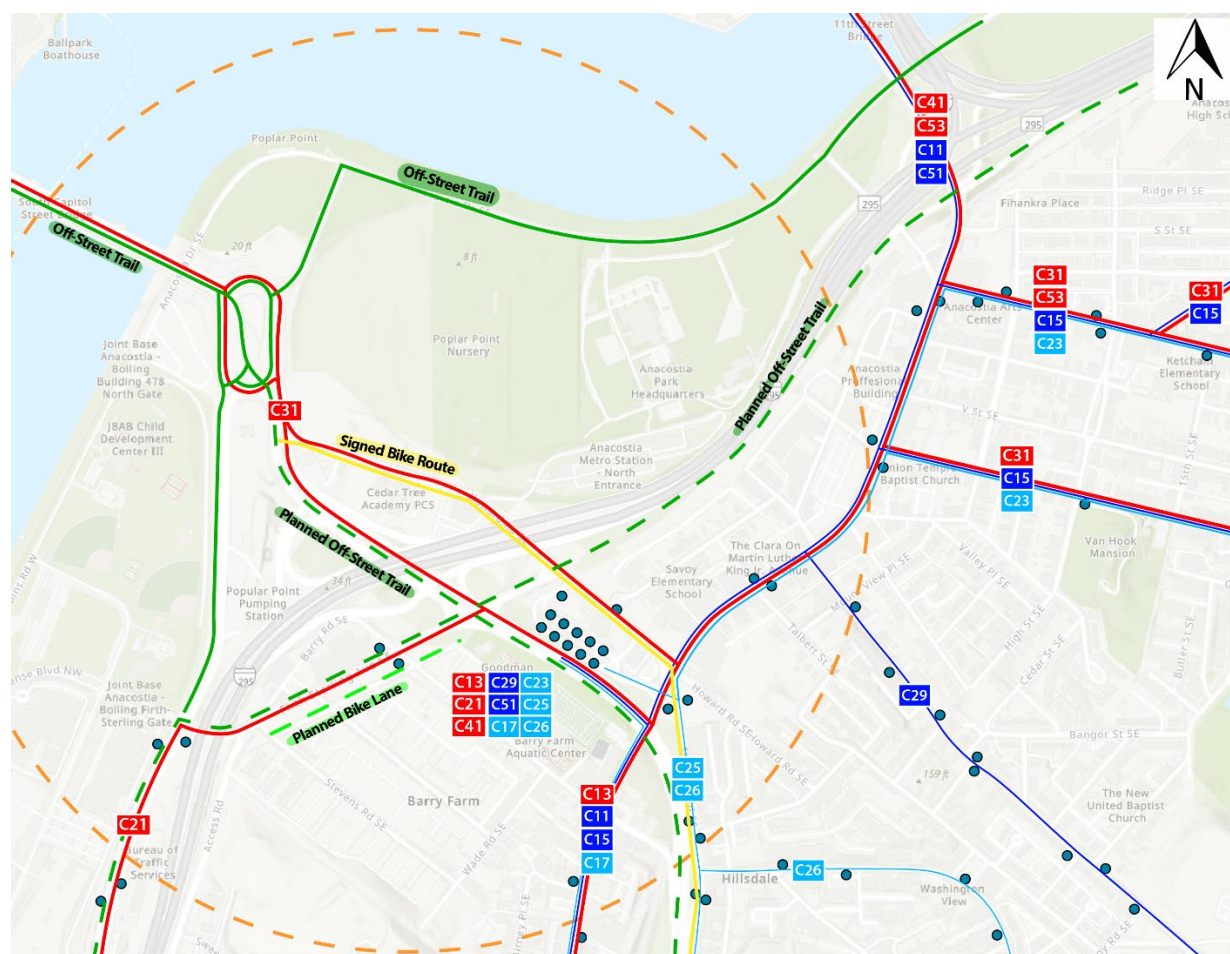
Bicycles are permitted on Metrorail and can be carried on Metrobus using the bicycle racks provided on the front of each bus. Information about bringing bicycles on metro buses is available [here](#) and guidance for traveling with bicycles on Metrorail is available [here](#).

The information below provides details about the Metrorail stations and Metrobus routes closest to the school.

**Metrorail:** The school is a five-minute walk from the WMATA's Green Line at the Anacostia Metro station.

**Metrobus:** The Anacostia Metrorail Station bus terminal is served by the following Metrobus routes: C11, C13, C15, C17, C21, C23, C25, C26, C29, C31, C41, C51. The table below details the frequency of each route. Schedules and routes for the buses can be found [here](#).

| Route | Route Name                       | Frequency                  |
|-------|----------------------------------|----------------------------|
| C11   | National Harbor-L'Enfant Plaza   | Every 20 minutes or better |
| C13   | MLK Avenue -Washington Highlands | Every 12 minutes or better |
| C15   | MLK Avenue-Southern Avenue       | Every 20 minutes or better |
| C17   | MLK Avenue -Bellevue             | Every 30 minutes or better |
| C21   | Alabama Avenue -Benning Road     | Every 12 minutes or better |
| C23   | Alabama Avenue Division Avenue   | Every 30 minutes or better |
| C25   | Pomeroy Road-Skyland             | Every 30 minutes or better |
| C26   | Stanton Road-Skyland             | Every 30 minutes or better |
| C29   | Anacostia-Southern Avenue        | Every 20 minutes or better |
| C31   | Capital Heights-Navy Yards       | Every 12 minutes or better |
| C41   | West Hyattsville-Anacostia       | Every 12 minutes or better |
| C51   | Tenleytown-Anacostia             | Every 20 minutes or better |



### **Driving & Parking**

Limited parking is available on-site for staff and visitors. Families should follow the designated arrival and dismissal procedures when dropping off or picking up students. Please avoid blocking driveways, crosswalks, bus stops, and travel lanes and obey all posted parking restrictions to help maintain safe operations around the school.
